NAME

CURLOPT_TLSAUTH_USERNAME – user name to use for TLS authentication

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_TLSAUTH_USERNAME, char *user);
```

DESCRIPTION

Pass a char * as parameter, which should point to the zero terminated username to use for the TLS authentication method specified with the *CURLOPT_TLSAUTH_TYPE(3)* option. Requires that the *CURLOPT_TLSAUTH_PASSWORD(3)* option also be set.
